Overview

The Texas Jazz Educators Association grants are designed to benefit Texas school jazz Programs. They are intended to provide financial support for jazz materials and/or clinicians. Proposals should be education-oriented. Preference will be given towards new or less experienced programs and proposals that impact the greatest number of students. You must be a TJEA member to apply.

Details

- Number of Grants Awarded Per Year: 10-12
 - o 5-6 high schools
 - o 5-6 elementary/middle/intermediate
 - o Number of grants awarded may increase based on monies available
- Maximum Award: \$500
- Programs are only eligible for one grant every three years
- Application Deadline is October 1
